- 2000 – 2001:** Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Head of the Western Europe division of the First Territorial Department
- 2001 – 2006:** First Secretary and Counsellor at the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Romania
- 2006 – 2009:** Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Deputy Head of the Department of Human Rights, Democratization and Humanitarian issues
- 1 August 2009 – 28 March 2013:** Counsellor of the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Romania
- 28 March 2013 – 27 June 2013:** Charge d'Affaires a.i. of the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Romania
- 27 June 2013 – present:** Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Romania
- 18 September 2013:** Ambassador Farid Abdinbayov presents the Letters of Credence to H.E. Mr. Traian Basescu, President of Romania
