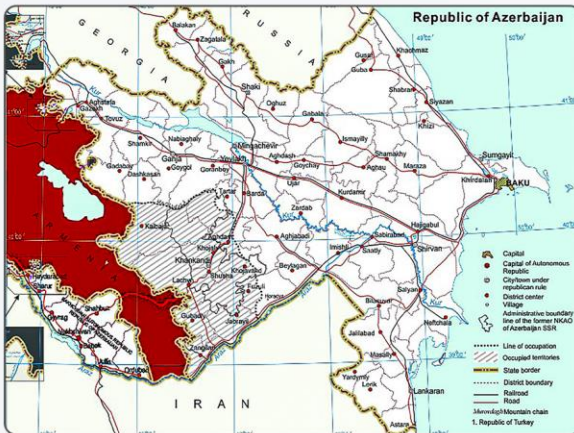
Since September 27, 2020 the armed forces of Armenia have been targeting the civilian population, private houses and civilian infrastructure in Azerbaijan in a deliberate, widespread and systematic manner. By doing so, Armenia grossly violates its obligations under international humanitarian law, including the 1949 Geneva Conventions and its Additional Protocols as well as disregards the humanitarian ceasefire declared on October 10, 18 and 26.

On November 05, Armenia continued to launch attacks in various directions, including across the international border with Azerbaijan. Tovuz, Gadabay and Dashkesan regions of Azerbaijan were subjected to artillery fire from the direction of Berd, Chambarak and Vardenis regions of Armenia.

As of November 05, as a result of Armenia's attack 92 civilians, including 10 children and 27 females, 404 civilians, including 50 children and 102 females have been hospitalized with serious injuries. Moreover, 2971 private houses, 100 apartment buildings and 502 civilian infrastructures were destroyed or damaged.

In total, 60% of killed and 62% of injured civilians became victims of Armenia's attacks far away from the zone military operations.
